Popcorn kernels need to be heated at 400 degrees Fahrenheit to become popcorn. You can cook it on the stove, in a microwave or in a popcorn popper.



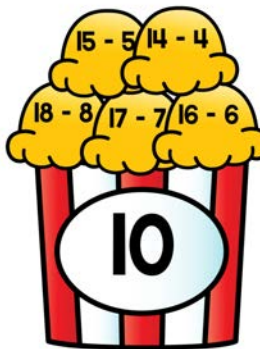
