

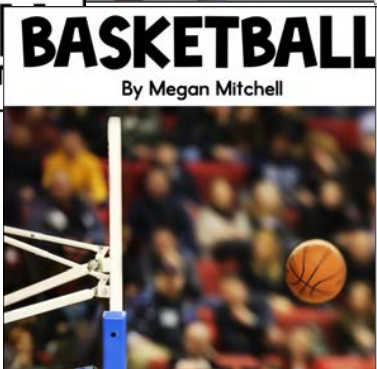

## WHAT IS BASKETBALL?

Basketball was invented in 1891. It is a popular team sport played over the world. The NBA (National Basketball Association) is the most-watched professional basketball league in the world. In 1996 a Women's National Basketball Association (WNBA) was established.




## BASKETBALL COURT

Basketball is played on a court. A court is a rectangle shape that is 94 ft wide. At the end of each short side is a basketball hoop that is 10 ft high, attached to a square backboard. A free throw line is used to help make a shot in the key, and a three-point line is also used to help keep the ball on the court, allowing it to bounce back into the key.



## OFFENSE & DEFENSE

Each team has 5 players on the court at one time. The team that has the ball is on offense. They are trying to get the ball in the basket to score points. The team that doesn't have the ball is on defense. They are trying to stop the players from scoring points. They put their hands up and follow the player with the ball. They try to take the ball away from the player.




## JUMP BALL

The game begins with a jump ball. One player from each team stands in the middle of the court. An official, or referee, throw the ball up in the air. The two players jump up and try to hit the ball with their hands so they can be on offense. The game begins, and the players run down the court.




## DRIBBLE, PASS, OR SHOOT

The ball is the star of the game, but there are rules you must follow when you have the ball. You must dribble or bounce the basketball when you are running down the court or moving with the ball. You can not carry the ball. If you stop dribbling, you must pass the ball to a teammate, or try to shoot the ball into the net. If you catch the ball after it hits the backboard or rim, it is called a rebound.




## LET'S SCORE

The object of the game is to score the most points at the end of the game. When players shoot the ball through the hoop, they get two points. If they shoot the ball beyond the three-point line, they get three points.



## FOUL & FREE THROWS

During a game, there are referees who make sure players are following the rules. They have a whistle and stop the game when a rule is broken. This is called a foul. Sometimes after a foul, a team can make a free throw. A free throw is taken at the free throw line. Each shot is worth one point. All the players stand behind the line. On the last shot, the shot is taken. On the last shot, the player tries to get the ball.



## QUARTERS OR HALVES

Basketball games are split into four quarters or two halves. Youth, high school, and professional basketball games are divided into four quarters with a half-time break in the middle. College basketball games are divided into two halves with a half-time break in the middle. During half-time, coaches talk with the players about their play.

## UNIFORMS

Basketball players do a lot of running, so they wear a loose fitting uniform. They wear sleeveless shirts and shorts with their team colors. College players wear special sneakers called high-tops. They are made to protect the ankle better. They have bottoms that keep them from skidding while running on the court.



## GLOSSARY

**backboard**-A large flat panel behind the basket. Players use it to bounce balls off it and into the net.  
**defense**-The team that doesn't have the ball.  
**dribble**-When players move from place to place while bouncing the ball with one hand the whole time.  
**foul**-When you break a rule in basketball.  
**free throw line**-A line painted on the court to stand behind when shooting free throws.  
**free throws**-Shooting baskets due to being fouled while everyone else stands still.  
**jump ball**-When the ball is tossed in the air at the beginning of the game and the players try to get it to begin playing.  
**key**-Shooting the basketball on the court near the net.  
**net**-The looped open fabric that the team tries to shoot the basketball into.  
**offense**-The team that has the ball.  
**pass**-When one player throws or bounces the ball to another player.  
**quarters**-Four timed sessions in a game.  
**rebound**- Catching the ball after it bounces off the backboard or rim.  
**referee**-The person who makes sure all the players are following the rules.  
**rim**-The ring around the net that holds it open.  
**steal**-When a player takes the ball away from the other team.

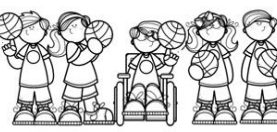

If you stop dribbling, you must **pass** the ball to a teammate, or try to shoot the ball into the net. If you catch the ball after it hits the backboard or rim, it is called a **rebound**.

# Let's Score

The object of the game is to score the most points at the end of the game. When players shoot the basketball through the net, they score two points. If they shoot the ball beyond the three-point line, they earn three points.



# Foul & Free Throws

During a game, there are **referees** who make sure players are following the rules. They have a whistle and stop the game when a rule is broken. This is called a **foul**. Sometimes after a foul, a team will get to make a **free throw**. A free throw is taken at the free throw line. Each shot is worth one point. All the players stand still while the shot is taken. On the last shot, they all try to get the ball.



# Uniforms

Basketball players do a lot of running so they wear a loose fitting uniform. They wear sleeveless shirts and baggy shorts with their team colors. Many players wear special sneakers called high-tops. They are made to prevent players from getting hurt. They protect the ankle better. They also have



# Quarters or Halves

Basketball games are split into four **quarters** or two **halves**. Youth, high school, and professional basketball games have 4 timed quarters with a half-time break in the middle. College basketball has two halves with a half-time break in between each half. During half-time, coaches talk with the players about their play.



# Glossary

**backboard**-A large flat panel behind the basket. Players use it to bounce balls off it and into the net.  
**defense**-The team that doesn't have the ball.  
**free throw**-A line positioned on the court to stand behind when shooting free throws.  
**free throw**-Shooting the ball while everyone else stands still.

**net**-The hooped open fabric that the team tries to shoot the basketball into.

**rebound**-Catching the ball after it bounces off the backboard or rim.  
**referee**-The person who makes sure all the players are following the rules.

**steal**-When a player takes the ball away from the other team.
