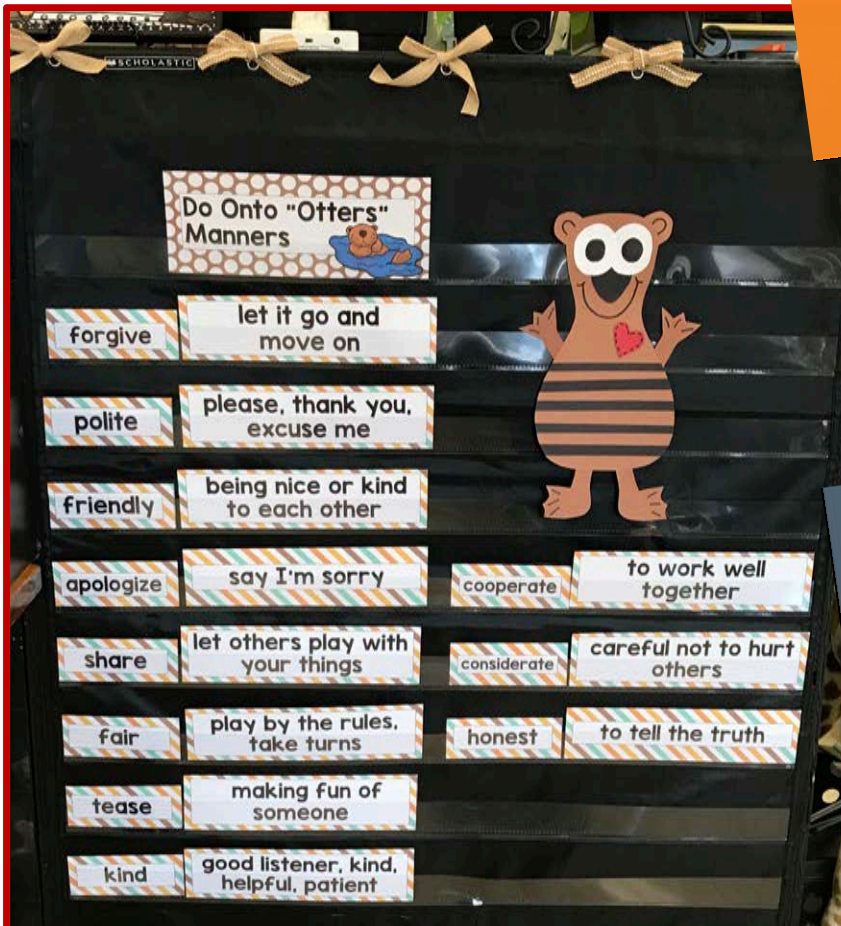
Rabbit learned that he was going to have new neighbors. They were otters. He wasn't sure how he felt.

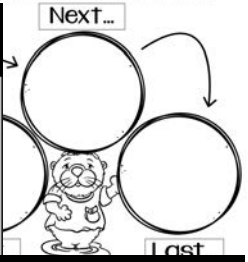
